



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Young Men,

Congratulations on your decision to participate in the upcoming Young Men's Ultimate Weekend! It will be an experience the young men never forget. This letter will provide you with the information you need to become part of this transformative experience for the young men and their families.

The final registration for initiation at the Young Men's Ultimate Weekend occurs on Thursday, June 17, between 5:30 p.m. until 7 p.m. Walk-in registration is permitted. Please arrive on time. We will provide dinner on Thursday night for the young men. See below for directions to the site at Loma Prieta School District Playground north of Santa Cruz.

It is critical that all young men be prepared for all possible types of activities and weather conditions. There may be poison oak around the campgrounds. Young men should bring the following items: sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight, batteries, athletic shoes, all-weather boots or shoes, gloves, hat, poncho/rain gear, swimming trunks, towel, extra clothing, and a toilet kit including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, insect repellent and sunscreen.

Our safety staff will be equipped with first aid and over-the-counter supplies. Any special medications must be supplied by the young man. The young men are not permitted to bring any of the following items: weapons, knives, electronic equipment (audio or visual), cell phones, tobacco (unless ages 18 or older), nonprescription drugs, marijuana, alcohol and tents. These items will be taken from the young men and returned upon completion of the Weekend.

Attn: Parents, Guardians and Sponsors

You are expected to arrive on Sunday at 3 p.m. sharp to participate in the one hour parenting program, "The RIGHT Way to Guide Young Men". You will learn how to apply the RIGHT Way® method to help your sons successfully prepare for adulthood. At the end of this workshop, you'll know how to help your sons develop the skills they learned at the Ultimate Weekend. After this presentation, the Weekend concludes at 4 p.m. in a heartfelt ceremony reuniting the young men and the adults with a heightened awareness of the importance of family and a greater appreciation for each other.

*This program is open to the public, so you're welcome to bring friends and family members. This closing ceremony will be remembered by all who attend. We look forward to meeting you at the Weekend!

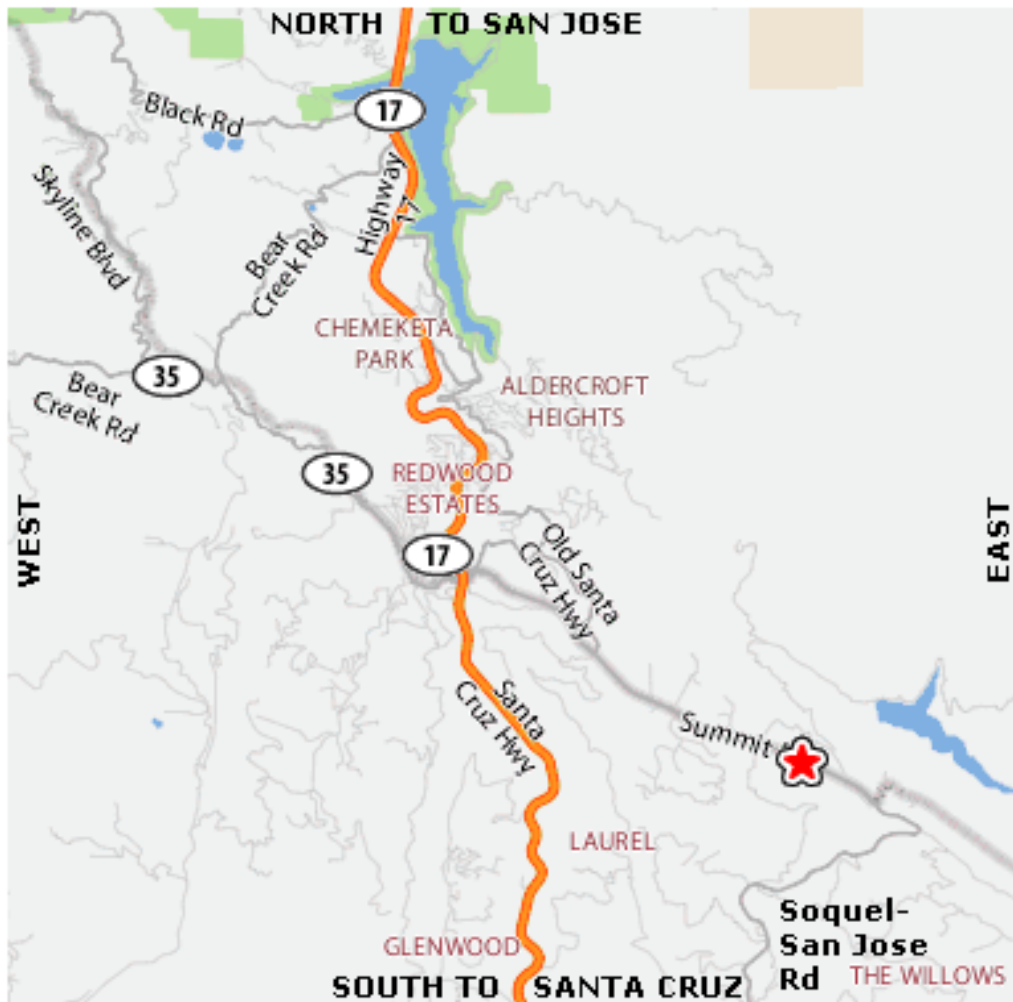
